



NFW RFCTOR

I have been asked to write a few lines about my past; difficult thing for anyone to do. But it did make me think a lot about who I am and where I have come from.

Although born in South London I have lived nearly all my life in the West Country (Dartmoor). I, quite literally, ran away from an over packed, loud, chaotic and loving home, for the Royal Navy aged 16. I think my family were glad of the space when I left! Then started a twenty-year career in the Navy's medical service, I served in hospitals and shore bases, ten years in Nuclear Submarines, ships and for a short while with a specialist Royal Marines unit. The Navy sorted out my dyslexia, got me my first and gave me my faith. This event took the loss of my closest friend, a deserted Antarctic Island and a pod of Orcas, but that's another tale.

Leaving the Navy at 36, I followed a quest for Ordination via a theological college in Oxford. Three years later at ordination, the bishop asked who I was, I don't think I made much of a mark! Training at Okehampton, then Rural Dean of Exeter and three Chaplaincies later I was Director of Chaplaincy and Psychology at my University; it might sound an odd mix but we had responsibility for bereavement, grief and loss as well as out of hours emergency response so all my team were duel qualified.

Marriage to Sarah followed and then we moved home to Devon and Covid! As I write this I am reminded of a student who died at University.

A staff member and I drove from Cardiff to the far end of Essex, to a very old and very beautiful, Baptist chapel overlooking the sea.

The young man's friends carried his bare wood coffin into church which they had covered it with messages of love and happiness in brightly coloured felt pens. We buried him in mid-October with Swallows dancing above his grave.

That young man's life was an adventure filled with humour, energy, love and faith. Thinking about my life I also recognise that all of the stages I have passed through have been adventures as well, good, sometimes bad but never alone; always with Jesus. A new adventure awaits me now in the Ruby Country Benefice to our south. I am to be licensed on the 24th May at St Mary's Black Torrington and I hope to see some of you there. Two things are certain, all the work there will be ecumenical, we are all equal brothers and sisters in Christ, and Sarah and I will not be taking this new adventure alone.

When you hear "Your Amazon account ..." you know you have another scam phone call. They are getting cheekier now or sneakier. My call came from 01288 352813. Unfortunately, I have only been able to leave a message on that number. It has now been consigned to my Junk Voicemail on 1572.

However, I know someone else who had the self same message and he found it originated from the same STD code, 01409, as his land line. That's what I mean getting extra sneaky. So if your Caller ID shows a local number it may be nothing more than a scam.

The Neighbourhood Alerts are very much to the point. Respect and Protect our Countryside is something we should all do. I'm sure all the local folk are aware of this. But tourists do sometimes think that the countryside is just that - open for all to enjoy. Not necessarily. The local fields are not park land, not even Dartmoor is free land. So, visitors take care. Litter - take it home for disposal - you brought it - don't leave it.

Dogs - please keep them on leads especially around animals - they can be shot if seen worrying sheep. Gates - please close them after you - farm animals may stray on to the roads.

And whilst you are out and about, please ensure that you have locked up where you are staying. If your stuff isn't on view there is less chance of it being nicked. Criminals have holidays too.

By the way, during the Coronation Tea in the village on Sunday May 7th
 please don't leave your property vulnerable to those who want to enjoy
 something else - of yours.

THERE HE IS!

Long years ago, I was a young trainee at London's prestigious Institute of Urological Surgery. Those were the times when Margaret Thatcher was in full-throated cry, seeing off the likes of General Galtieri abroad, and Arthur Scargill at home.

Our Urology Institute too had a fierce reputation, for excellence in treatment of urinary diseases and research. In addition, it had several time-honoured traditions, like never appearing in the wards without a properly knotted tie. Amongst its many customs, was the annual Christmas dinner for consultants and registrars.

That year in 1986, the formal dinner was at the Garrick Club on Drury Lane. As the senior most registrar, it was my privilege to sit next to our Rex Imperator, Professor John Blandy, director of the Institute. The sumptuous repast enjoyably progressed, and soon the hour for the loyal toast was at hand. I passed the port decanter to Prof (and yes, I was seated on the correct side!). With a benign smile, a rare occurrence, Prof turned to me, 'You know, Gautam,' he said. 'I too was born in India.' I politely enquired his exact birthplace. 'Oh, Calcutta,' he said, and with an airy wave added, 'My father was a civil service mandarin in the Raj.' Prof paused to sip his port. 'He became President of the Calcutta Club. Great honour, you know.' Prof then moved on to speak with his other neighbour, the Lord Provost of the City of London.

Recently, Susan and I were getting some winter sun in Kerala, where the warm waters of the Arabian Sea lap over your toes as you lie on the hot sand. Having soaked up enough sunshine to replenish our Vitamin D levels, we headed for Calcutta, where I still have friends, some relatives, and a rather nice ancestral home. These days, the city's name has been changed (to my mind for the worse) to the less impressive, Kolkata. But here too, traditions run deep.

The premier gentlemen's club of the city, is the Calcutta Club which lies at the heart of the metropolis. It is very close to the Royal Calcutta Turf Club and the Victoria Memorial, a magnificent monument of pure white marble. The Calcutta Club itself is a massive white-washed Palladian mansion. It too boasts a superb dining room, like the Garrick.

Susan and I had been invited for lunch by an old school chum, an eminent city heart surgeon. As we sat on velvet sofas in the pleasantly air-cooled Crystal Room, a bearer in fan-tailed turban came for our drinks order. I wanted a cold beer, but my friend would have none of it. 'Nonsense,' he said. 'Scotch, for guest sahib,' he ordered, in a no-nonsense voice like Prof Blandy. 'Eighteen-year Lagavulin, burra peg,' he specified. He also instructed the man to send along the Maître D with the lunch menus. I noted with approval that the soup d'jour was chicken consommé, and the specials included lobster thermidor.

With my second whisky in hand (my heart surgeon friend had insisted), we got up from the Crystal Room. As we headed for lunch, we crossed the lobby which had a busy reception desk with old-world rotary telephones attended by smart young women in crisply pinned saris. High up on the wall above the desk was a polished board to which my attention was drawn. Particularly, to the names inscribed on the mahogany. All illustrious past presidents of the Calcutta Club.

I paused to look.

And there he was — amongst the rajas and maharajas, the knights of the realm — Sir Eric Blandy, President of the Calcutta Club, 1932-33.

I raised my whisky glass to Sir Eric. And his illustrious son. Both now dead. But forever etched in glorious memory.

Gmail and Outlook users urged to delete these emails

In times of financial difficulties cyber criminals become increasingly active and will use any method to get at your money, personal information or belongings.

Phishing scams are the most common and will masquerade as a well-known or reputable company. These emails often have a subject line which refers to some previous contact, even if its false. Beware of the following examples

"Your delivery was unsuccessful"

"You've won a prize!"

"You contacted us first"

"Your subscription is expiring"

"You could be a millionaire"

"ALERT: Your PC may be infected!"

Don't open these or others with a similar subject line, just delete them, better still blacklist them!

DONT IGNORE THE DOT!

APPLE and GOOGLE now have warnings signs on your smart phone you shouldn't ignore. They can reveal when you're being spied on by rogue apps.

A green dot signifies that your camera is active – but if it's orange, your microphone is in use, if a grey arrow is shown your location is being displayed.

Some Apps need to access these to work WhatsApp and Zoom are just two. But some apps use them for nefarious purposes, and you will not know which they, that is until now!

Monitoring the dots, located in the status bar on the screen, will make you aware which app is using these devices and when. If a small clear or blue arrow spears it shows a legitimate app is in use, this will also appear in the top right corner of the screen.



For Android phones, look for a small green pill icon in the top right. You'll see it appear with a small camera or microphone icon inside it.

Both can appear inside the pill icon at the same time. These signals alert you when an app is accessing your camera or microphone.

If your location is in use, you should see a small pin icon on the status bar near your battery. You can then view your apps folder (in Settings) to see which app it relates to and if preferred, delete it!




