The cost of AI is to be felt by everyone!

Much is being said about AI and it is a very exciting, concerning and an uncertain time as artificial intelligence is FORCED upon us.

But, don't rush out and buy a new one, newly bought machines can be 18 months old as they have travelled the high seas for 6 months, or more, or stuck in a distributors warehouse as sales have dropped. Some video and graphic drivers may need to be updated as improved Video morphing will become a new plaything in Laptops, Tablets and Phones. "You ain't seen nothing yet!" Was one comment I received when discussing it recently.

All very exciting and very dangerous, hackers are ahead of the game and legislation is likely to be as toothless as ever. Enjoy the ride, but it could be very bumpy! Beware the elaborate cons, there are plenty, and some will be truly horrendous!

In the May/June Buzz of 2012 the Editor Spotlighted Gary and Pam of The Bridge Inn. She now feels it would be appropriate to return to the Spotlight and Pam has kindly agreed.

It read:

Spotlight on Bridgerule's friendly landlord and landlady.

Gary Bowler was born on 18th April 1945 in Sutton-in-Ashfield in Nottinghamshire. He went to Eastbourne Secondary Modern school until the age of 15. Gary then started working in a shoe factory, making boots and shoes. Boots mainly for the then coal miners to wear down the pit and gaining his City & Guilds certificate for shoe making during this time.

For the following eight months Gary worked at the Royal Mint as a press machinist, making money! He also worked for a while as a roofer and later as a furnace man, in Sheepridge casting for Jumbo Jet Engines. A few years later in 1969, when he and his previous partner moved to Barnstaple Gary began working for the Clarks shoe factory. Firstly making shoes and later becoming a charge hand at the factory. It was whilst working at Clarks that he became friendly, in fact very friendly, with another employee, a Pam Gammon. Pam was born on 18th June 1953 and lived at Black Torrington. Pam attended Ashford school and as her parents didn't want Pam to 'mix

with the boys' she began her secondary education at Barnstaple All Girls School.

In 1975 Gary and Pam married at Barnstaple Registry Office and set up their first home together living in a flat above the local shop in Georgeham. Gary played football for Georgeham and later managed the team. It was whilst living here that they both became very friendly with a delightful young man called Danny.



Danny was the son of the shop owners and regularly visited Gary and Pam in their flat after work. Sadly one day Danny was diagnosed with leukaemia and at the age of 13 he passed away. Before his passing away Danny was the first person to receive Bone Marrow in the Exeter Hospital. Today there is a ward named after him called the Danny Webb Ward. A few years' later Gary and Pam bought their first home and moved to Croyde and in 1977 Paul their first son was born in Barnstaple Hospital, six weeks early. Pam, finishing work at Clarks on a Friday and baby being born the following Wednesday. Two years later, their second son, Mark was born. Their third son, Wayne, was born in 1984, but sadly and very tragically Wayne met with an accident in 2003 at the young age of 20 and consequently died. Wayne had played pool for Cornwall.

Pam enjoyed doing bed and breakfast and it was at this time that the management of Clarks threatened that the factory would soon shut. Gary feeling that he may become redundant at the age of forty decided to look for new employment. By now Gary and Pam had three sons and three dogs and the criteria for the new venture was to live near the sea and if it was to be a pub, this pub had to have an entrance with a back door which could be used privately by the family. June 1986 the Bowler family became the new owners of 'The Bridge Inn', taking over from Sonny and Bet Houghton. Everything it seemed was then painted green in the pub and in their words a bit run down. To get it to Pam's standards it took quite a lot of elbow grease from both of them.

They can both remember that to buy a pint of Flowers Original at that time was 88p a pint – now the same pint will cost you £2.90! (2012) Another great change they have seen, for the better, was the fact that the 'no smoking' in the pub ban meant that the premises remained a lot cleaner and healthier. Anyone who wished to use the toilets at The Bridge Inn when Gary and Pam first came might have got wet to have used them. Gary soon though rectified this. Upon completing some of the alterations to the living quarters of the pub Gary's dad and mum moved to Bridgerule.

Sadly after a while dad became quite ill and sadly passed away. Just after this Gary and Pam decided to close the pub at lunch times.

Gary and Pam reminisced with me on some of the characters they could remember coming into the pub during those early years. Sadly these people have all passed away but names that were fondly recalled were, Ern Venner, Dickie Piper, Don Nolan, Mac and Jean Gardener, Ned Honey, Tom Honey, Bill Cholwill and Reg Hollis. Shops at the time recalled in the village were Don and Sylvia Nolan's antiques with the one window full of lovely linen. Dickie and Dot's shop beside the pub – Pam remembering the cabinet full of cottons and sylko and John Moore at the Post Office with the late Jean Mariner helping him out on a Thursday (pension day).

I asked Pam if she could recall a 'funny' incident that had happened and the following came to mind immediately! On a hot sunny Sunday a certain Ian Hetherington, John McArdle, Tony Wallis and Kelvin Edwards were playing cards outside the pub. Gary thought he would have a bit of fun and nipped upstairs and threw a pan of water down from the bedroom window over the unsuspecting card players and immediately returned to his place behind the bar. These euchre players thought that Pam had done the dirty deed and so quickly found her, picked her up and carried her to the river and promptly threw her in.

Both of them remember how generous people were when they came to The Bridge Inn. Not only of their time but also with

materials. Tony Goodman doing a lot of building works for Gary. In 2012 Gary and Pam had 5 grandchildren. Twins Jack and Lucy aged 18 living in Ashfield, Millie aged 13, Jago aged 6 and Ruby aged 3 all living locally. Pam and Gary enjoy time in their garden or walking the dogs. They



have also raised large sums of money for various charities over the years. THANK YOU GARY & PAM

Whenever I finish one of these notes, there is always something of interest comes up in the neighbourhood Alert system.

There is, since April, a new Devon and Cornwall police website at "www.devon-cornwall.police.uk". For any non emergency issue we are asked to use this rather than phoning 101 or use email to 101. On the website you can report crime; abuse; road traffic incident or anti-social behaviour amongst others. Also fraud, bribery or corruption. Have a look.

So do keep your things to yourself. Lock up your house; windows; barns and sheds and vehicles. Yes, it is very hot at the moment of writing - with some chance of rain - but if you are away from somewhere don't leave it open. I do hope that you are keeping up with the programme on Scam Interceptors. Why is it that the scammer's voice is always the same, or hears so. I have had two phone calls from the same voice, trying it on - but I just put the phone down. Do the same. They only tell lies.

A recent Alert concerns visiting festivals, close to or away from the sea. Use of drugs and alcohol when trying to swim or bathe is dangerous and could be fatal. You know it makes sense not to. Holiday and festival time always means more traffic on the road. So give yourself plenty of time, have enough fuel, water for drinking and refreshments.

Devon County Council is funding for filling more pot holes in "minor roads" in the next few months. I do hope so.

Devon and Cornwall police have various operations stopping vehicles. Many arrests have been made for drug and drink driving and other illegal matters. They are always on watch in the County Lines operation for drug pushing.

But at the end of the day keep yourself safe and have a regard for your neighbours. Still use 999 if you see something strange, peculiar or illegal happening.
