Mervyn and Sylvia (nee Luxton) were married at Ashwater Methodist Chapel on the 26th April 1969 by the Rev. Ibbotson, who at the time resided at the then Methodist Manse at Morwenna Bridgerule. Their wedding happened to be on the FA Cup Final Day.

The reception was held at Eagle House Hotel at Launceston and the honeymoon was spent touring The Lake District and North Wales.

The newlyweds then returned to farm at Elm Park for the next 41 years and expanded their business by purchasing more land and also began taking in tourists for holiday bed, breakfast and evening meals. The bed and breakfast continued until Mervyn and Sylvia moved to Bude.

Mervyn and Sylvia have 2 sons, Richard who farms with his wife Tracey and their family at Bradford and Barry, who farms at Elm Park with Lisa, his wife and family. Together the whole Lucas family farm in partnership.

When Barry moved into Elm Park after his marriage, Mervyn and Sylvia moved to 19 Littlebridge Meadows Bridgerule where they remained for the next five years. They now live in Bude but Mervyn still returns to help on the farm each day.

The Lucas family have been farming in Bridgerule since the 1880's. Mervyn's grandfather, Mr. James Lucas, farmed at Southlands and his father, Mr Fred Lucas farmed at Elm Park. Mr James Lucas also had a traction engine business and a seed and corn merchant who would sail from Bude to Ireland to buy seed corn.

Elm Park (as seen in the photo) was converted from 3 thatched cottages to the present farmhouse in 1939.



Mervyn served as a Parish Councillor for Bridgerule for many years and both he and Sylvia are closely associated with Bridgerule Methodist Chapel. Mervyn being a steward and both have been past secretaries for the chapel and regularly return to the weekly services. Sylvia being a member of The Tamraside Singers. Both are still very interested and supporters of local events which take place in the village.

Mervyn and Sylvia have 4 grandchildren, Rebecca, Daniel, William and Phoebe.

The Lucas family have been very supportive of the Revel Week each year and for the past 40 years have entered a carnival tableaux.

Mervyn and Sylvia's main hobbies are centred around the family farm. They also enjoy going on coach holidays, travelling all over Europe and The British Isles.

Family and friends celebrated Mervyn and Sylvia's Golden Wedding recently by a party held at Trethorne Leisure Park.

Computer Tips

Windows 7 users

Microsoft will stop supporting windows 7 from 14th January 2020. It means patches, fixes and updates will stop, making the windows program vulnerable to attack from hackers. Many existing computers can be upgraded to windows 10 avoiding the need to buy a new machine. A few basic tests could save you a few hundred pounds. If you plan to continue using Windows 7 make sure your system is fully protected.



Crypto Currency



Several local people have been duped into investing in crypto currency such as Bit Coins believing they'll make easy money. Investing in this highly volatile, unregulated market is very risky. Many investors have seen their life savings disappear into a black hole! Investing in 'can't lose' crypto currency can cost you thousands of pounds. Only invest in these products if

you understand the market and are prepared to lose your investment. Don't listen to salesmen who say you can make a fortune, you'll only end up on a 'mugs' list.

Need a New printer?

Repairing an old printer can be more costly than buying a new one but, adopting a self-help attitude can save you money and get your printer working. Many old printers have out of date "firmware" (printer's internal program). Windows 10 doesn't recognise some older drivers and renders the printer as being "offline". Update printer firmware, printer drivers and reset the wi-fi link can all help resolve printer "offline" faults.

Some A-V programs are failing to provide full computer protection and it's worth double checking your system for infected files, you may be paying for something you're not actually receiving.
