Birthday Surprise!

My birthday surprise started back in May this year when I started to experience light headedness together with faint palpitations and an erratic pulse. As I have had a pacemaker for 8 years and these episodes only lasted about 10 seconds and were sometimes days apart I wasn't too concerned. My pacemaker had had its 6 monthly checks in April. I did try to contact the ECG department but was told I wasn't on their list of patients.



Over the next couple of weeks, the episodes increased in numbers, so I insisted on seeing my doctor face to face. An ECG didn't reveal anything but my doctor referred me to the cardiology unit. Initially of course it was a phone appointment but the consultant was very thorough and booked me in for further tests. Unfortunately, before the tests materialised, I had a particularly bad episode after a week of strenuous work. After calling 111. I was told to get to A&E at Barnstaple. This resulted in me being kept in hospital for 3 days where a check was carried out on my pacemaker and showed no problem. I was eventually discharged and was told I would get an appointment for 48 hours monitor and an echogram.

The appointment came to collect the monitor 10 days later and to return it after 48 hours. As I had not received an appointment for the echogram, I contacted the consultant by telephone and it was arranged for me to have the echogram when I returned the monitor. The technician was not happy with the results of the echogram and telephoned my consultant, which happened to be a Sunday and said they would look at the results Monday morning. By Tuesday I had not heard anything so contacted the consultant again, who said the chief consultant was away for the week and they weren't too concerned but they would probably organise an angiogram in a few weeks' time and that as long as I felt ok I could continue to drive and go away to Sussex for a week to see our families.

As I was feeling ok, but still experiencing the episodes, we decided to travel on my birthday the following Monday to Sussex for unknown to me, a surprise party with family coming from various places. So at 10 am we set off for the 200 mile journey, car loaded with all our baggage and Bella (our lovely 13 year old dog).

I forgot to mention on our front door we have a cctv camera, which is linked to my phone. East of Honiton my phone bleeped a couple of times and my wife looked at it and said there were 2 missed calls from a Barnstaple number. While at Eype, where we stopped for a toilet break I also noticed a answerphone message which I played only to find out it was a registrar asking me to call him urgently. I was put through immediately and he said I needed to go straight to Barnstaple hospital as they had looked at my monitor results and it showed I had over 500 episodes and my pacemaker was not working correctly. What he hadn't told me was he tried my home number as well and after getting no reply had put emergency things in motion.

As we were about 90 miles from home and then a further 40 miles from Barnstaple it was obvious that a diagonal route across country would be a lot quicker, but what to do with Bella was the next problem. Remembering our friends were at an Exeter hospital for some checks we contacted them and arranged to meet them there so they could take Bella back with them. So, after receiving the first missed call at 10:45 we eventually arrived at Barnstaple hospital where I was directed to the A&E for Covid checks at 15:45. As Lyndsey was not allowed in, she went to wait in the car only to get to the car park and came to the assistance of a man who had collapsed. Guys always marry an ex-nurse.

I eventually saw the triage nurse at 16:10 and while going through the normal checks with her, my telephone bleeped twice and of course I couldn't answer it—until I returned to the waiting room. I saw on my phone that the front door bell had rang so I played the video back only to see 2 paramedics and 2 firemen banging on our front door and shouting through the letter box.

Unfortunately, the video only lasted 30 seconds as I had removed motion detection to save on battery life. I went live on the telephone 15 minutes after the event but couldn't see anybody. At that point they must have all been around the rear of the house. For peace of mind I called our friends who picked up Bella and asked them to go round and check the house. On arrival and getting past the road block of emergency vehicles he arrived at our front door just in time to stop them breaking the front door down.

Outcome was I had 3 more days in hospital and the pacemaker was found to have a faulty circuit which has now been bypassed. The pacemaker technician told me in hospital that if I had spoken to them back in May then they could have sorted it straight away.!!!

Moral of this story. Answer your phone as soon as it rings. And don't be fobbed off with telephone appointments if you genuinely are not well.

She introduced herself as an 88 year old deaf lady ... who could only choose 2 items to bring with her - a mask - her reading glasses - or her hearing aids she chose to leave her hearing aids at home !!!! The conversation was a little tricky to say the least - some bits she missed completely - and some sentences/subjects didn't always follow as they should. Sadly her husband had died about 17 years ago and this was a brave 'first' for her - a trip out on her own. When Chris paid for our meals Betty lent over to me and with a saucy grin asked if she could borrow him and after a bit of thought she asked... how long did I think he'd last !!!!! From then on it was a laugh a minute. She was an amazing find - on a really enjoyable day out.

We've had fun - a great time.

For a Cold Fork Buffet which included cold roast rib of English beef - leg of pork - sugar baked gammon - assorted salads etc. - with fruit salad and dairy cream - 2 choices of gateau - cheeses and coffee - 93p per person !! This included provision of all crockery and cutlery. The wine service was based on £6 per 100

guests and a glass hire of 18p per dozen. Wedding cakes could be supplied at prices from £6 to £20. My Dad being Welsh and always very 'careful' with his money thought this was extortionate.

My wedding ring cost £9 - my bouquet was £5.50 and Bridesmaid's posy was £2.10. The wedding dress was £14 - a sale item - and unusually Chris came along to help choose it !!!!!

A new email threat worries experts

There's a new email scam threat appearing in inboxes and it's like nothing that's been seen before.

Gmail and Outlook users are targeted with messages that large purchases have been made via Amazon, Paypal, Facebook and WhatsApp and it uses a new way of targeting consumers with convincing messages and official logos.

This is a slick operation for if you fall for the trick, you're forced to telephone a number where a person acting as the agent answers and begins to act as you would expect a customer service agent to respond.

If you allow that responder to access your computer a Trojan virus will be activate on your computer. You may have an active antivirus program protecting your computer, but my experience is that not all AV's are as competent as you may believe.

Here are some top tips to avoid this new vishing scam.

- . DO NOT ring or call any number given in the email or text.
- DO NOT click on any links in the email or text. Log into your account with the service in question type the address into your browser; check your orders or recent activity page.
- Check your balance and the list of recent transactions on all your cards, if you have reason for concern.... telephone your Bank or Credit Card Company and inform them, ask them to place a watch on your account and stop any unusual transactions.

Windows 11 Update

Before you run out to buy a new computer to use the new windows 11 operating system. Hold On! There is a legal way to install it on your existing computer, no matter how old it may be and it doesn't need the additional security TPM chip to do

so. But it must already have windows 10 installed and activated.

The process utilizes the current Windows 10 installer system, but uses the Windows 11 install file. I have produced a fact sheet and DVD for those who are interested.

I have now installed Windows 11 on over a dozen systems of varying ages and manufacture, but will only operate the 64bit software.

Some users have found the new program difficult to use, but all the old procedures remain, but in different places! And there are several new screen formations
