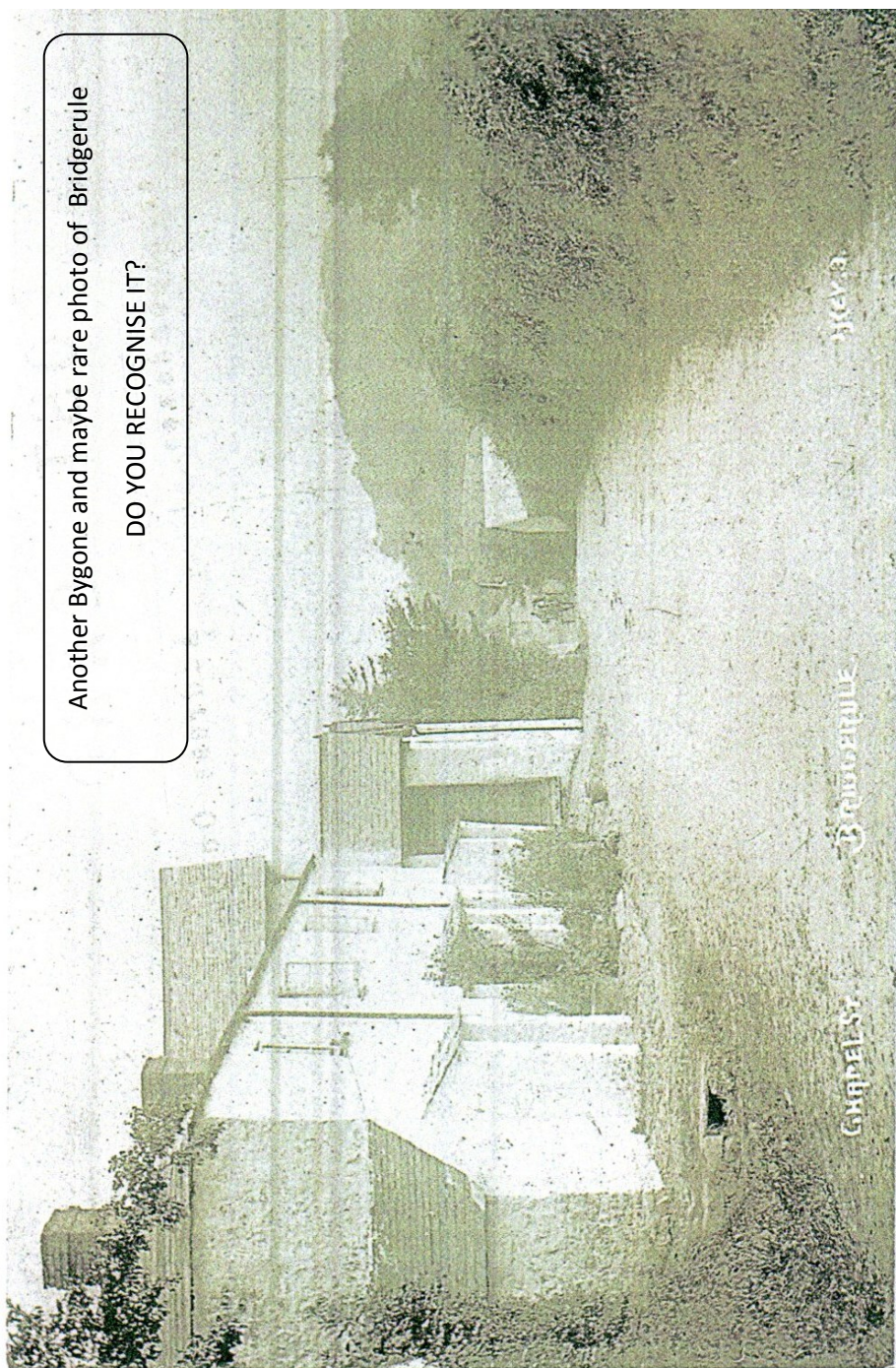
Their special week with the family provided many memories and everyone got to know 12 week old Joshua, their most recent grandchild.

Spotlight on Karen Thomas.....

What on earth am I going to say? I don't have children and I don't go to church!" was my first response on being asked if I'd mind being Spotlight for The Bridgerule Buzz.

As I'm sure is the case with a lot of us, I feel as though my life so far has passed in a blur of work. Until I was fortunate enough to move to Bridgerule two and a half years ago that is!

Firstly, I have to say what a pleasure it is living in such a friendly, beautiful village. Like a lot of incomers, we lurked around talking to people before we took the plunge to move here. Myself and David were walking our dogs last week and came upon people doing the same. "It seems too good to be true here" they said. We just laughed because we remembered that feeling so well, and were able to reassure them that it is indeed as good as it seems!

I was brought up by loving parents, with no siblings. Living first in Holtspur, then Flackwell Heath near High Wycombe, schooling passed by uneventfully with, to put it kindly, mediocre results in everything bar Art and English. This continued through to Amersham College, where I'm ashamed to admit I would often 'bunk off' my own subjects to hang out in the painting and pottery classes!

My first job was admin in a design and marketing agency. Once again I could be found in the art and design studio during my breaks. I should have seen a trend, but we are often blind to destiny giving us the largest of taps on the shoulder. Our mutual love of music drew myself and my lovely husband David together.

We met at a gig at a not-very-salubrious venue, The Pegasus at Marlow Bottom. Hollering at one another over the band, we arranged a date at the very sophisticated Jasmine Chinese Restaurant in Beaconsfield. Five years later at the same place, David proposed. The carved carrot parrot which must have taken hours that came with the Peking duck should have given the game away, as should the grinning waiters, but I was taken completely by surprise! We set up home together in Maidenhead and married in June 1998.



In a spectacular display of luck, a consultant came to my place of work to whip it into shape he had to share my office. He thought I was under-challenged in my role (code for hyperactive maybe?!) and saw my skill with people. He mentored me through a period of study with the Chartered Institute of Personnel & Development and I subsequently became a “trainer-for-hire” - a contractor in the period leading up to the millennium involved in Client Relationship Management (CRM) projects. So it was that at 25 I was self-employed as part of a project team, thoroughly enjoying my new career teaching at, amongst others, the BBC, Sun Microsystems, Hewlett-Packard and Cellnet (as it was known then).

The millennium bubble inevitably burst, myself and David had grown weary of commuting and were aware that our skills were pretty specific to big cities. We went through a period of considering emigrating to New Zealand. New Zealand has a list of skills they are short of and therefore those in possession can gain access to the country more easily. David’s health took an unfortunate turn and I became increasingly sure that a ‘job in a box’ as I put it - a trade or craft - could provide long-term financial security.

Hairdressing fit both bills, so with my usual over-exuberance I set about becoming a good one. Toni and Guy & Vidal Sassoon academies followed then I set up a salon in Maidenhead. David followed, training the year after me and we worked together for ten years in our salon, far busier than either of us could have predicted. We sold the salon to move to Bridgerule.

Overlapping this period, I became increasingly active in sports and fitness, racing a lot of weekends, running marathons and fixing my body afterwards with pilates. In 2011 I decided to qualify as a studio pilates instructor, slightly different to the pilates most people know of as it is more associated with remedial applications. Two years later, once qualified, I set up a studio in a large log cabin in my garden and worked Wednesdays (stolen from the salon) and evenings. I duplicated this setup when I moved to Bridgerule and once again, have the studio in the back garden.



Which brings us to present day. Another funny thing happened when we moved here. I started to become aware of the amazing quality of light down here and suddenly had more time to notice the beauty of nature .

At first I could be found racing late into the evening with my camera, but this quickly turned to art, specifically watercolour. After some initial lessons as part of Lynne Holehouses' class in Bude, I felt a strong desire to immerse myself in learning every aspect of it. For the last year-and-a-half I've travelled to Dorset every two weeks to learn under my favourite artist. I've gone on three painting holidays, created lots of art, attended country shows and events all over the South West with my paintings and I've been lucky enough to be shown in galleries from Kilkhampton to Tiverton. My first solo exhibition was held at Bude Castle in June.

A recent highlight has been being involved to exhibit at the National Trust's Cotehele from October to December, a proud moment for any up-and-coming artist.



The future? Myself and David are very happy here. I paint, while he serenades me with guitar! The pilates studio is gradually becoming an art and framing studio and at some stage in the future I would be thrilled to combine my love of water colour with teaching. I work hard to improve at some aspect of my painting every day. I'm truly blessed and feel full of gratitude to be finally doing what I believe I was always meant to do. I have to say this is the best period of my life so far, certainly the most exciting! I might never have had my artistic leanings rekindled if I hadn't moved to Bridgerule!

Karen and David live at The Forge and I thank Karen for the very interesting Spotlight. A very talented lady who is now part of our community. I bet there are a lot of Buzz readers who had no idea of Karen's artistic flair. One of her favorite's is to the right. Truly brilliant!



**MICHAEL'S
LATEST MODEL**



GIANT LORRY CRANE

The model is a representation of a Smith T35 truck crane on a Foden 8 x 4 low line crane carrier chassis built in 1967. The model's length is 4'4" (1.33 metres). Its width is 1'6" (0.46 metres). The jib length is 4'2" (1.27 metres). The main gearbox has five forward gears and one reverse followed by a two speed splitter.

It took 3016 parts and over 6000 nuts and bolts to build this model.

There are four electric power drive motors used; one to drive the six gears to the road wheels, one to work the turn table, one lifting and lowering the jib, and one for hook winding drum.

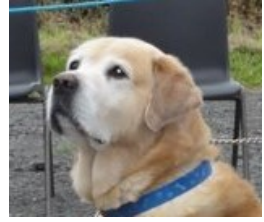

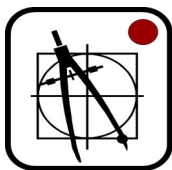
