#### HOLSWORTHY RURAL COMMUNITY TRANSPORT - Julia Foster

Are you stuck at home with transport troubles? If so, then Holsworthy Rural Community Transport may well be able to help you out. Holsworthy Rural Community Transport is a charity dedicated to providing community transport for the people of Holsworthy & the surrounding area, so Bridgerule is a key parish for our operations.

This organisation offers real support to people of all ages who need transport living in our rurally isolated area with its limited public transport network & you may perhaps not be aware of all that it has to offer.

Users of our service say that it is a "lifeline" & that it makes them feel more independent because they don't need to rely on friends or family to give them lifts.

#### Who is Eligible?

Many people in our community are not even aware that they are eligible to take advantage of our services. Are you one of these people? If you have difficulty accessing public transport, have no access to transport of your own during the day or if you have special mobility needs then you will be eligible to take advantage of our services, whatever your age. Even if someone else in your household has a vehicle, if he or she uses that vehicle during the day to go to work, leaving you at home without any transport, then you will be able to use our services.

#### Here is a summary of the services we offer:

#### Ring & Ride Service

Our Ring and Ride service offers a wheelchair accessible minibus picking you up directly from your own home & taking you to local towns for shopping trips, lunch trips & visits. There are daily trips to predefined destinations which our users may otherwise be unlikely to be able to visit.

#### Shopping trips are run to destinations such as:

Bude Holsworthy
Okehampton Launceston
Atlantic Village Tavistock
Truro Kernow Mill

All these shopping trips include access both to supermarkets & other shops.

#### Lunch trips include:

The London Inn at St.Neot Dartmoor
St Mellion Golf Club Westward Ho!
Route 38 Hill Top Farm Shop

Drewsteignton

#### Longer trips to places of interest in our beautiful South West region include:

Boscastle Westward Ho! Falmouth Lynton & Lynmouth Homeleigh Garden Centre Sidmouth (including Donkey Sanctuary)
Paignton (including Zoo) Salcombe St Ives
Exmouth Looe Penzance

So there is a huge variety of appealing destinations on offer *via* this service.

To use the service all you need to do is register with the office & then you can start booking trips! Our driver will collect you from home & take you back there afterwards, helping you with shopping bags if necessary. The price varies in relation to the destination, starting from £4.50 for the shorter trips & from £5.50 for the longer trips.

#### **Volunteer Car Service**

Our Volunteer Car scheme offers a taxi style service using volunteer car drivers for people requiring transport to important appointments, such as doctors surgeries and hospitals. It is a taxi-like service, used when no other transport arrangement can be made. It is provided by volunteer drivers who use their own transport. They pick you up from your home, take you to your appointment, wait for you & bring you back home afterwards. As well as those who have no access to transport of their own or who have difficulty accessing public transport, if a person is temporarily unable to drive, perhaps for medical reasons, then he or she would also be eligible to use this service. There is a small charge of 45p per mile to cover the volunteer's cost of fuel.

#### **Community Mini Bus Hire**

Are you a local youth group, sports team or charity which needs to transport your members to venues? Our two 16-seater minibuses are available at evenings and weekends for hire to local charities and community groups. They can be either self-drive, or hired with a driver & the cost is very reasonably priced at £40 per day or £25 per evening plus fuel (& driver cost if applicable).

Hi Sheila,

#### I thought Buzz readers might like to consider this.

I have been a loyal customer of Flogas for 8 years and have 2 x 47kg tanks regularly delivered. The price has increased from about £100 for 2 tanks at the beginning to £134 last October and now £156, over £20 increase in a few months. I have spoken to Flogas before about excessive increases but they have always said there was nothing they could do, although I explained I was older and had serious health problems and needed to keep my central heating on, which I could not do, due to the cost of Flogas.

This time I complained online and was sent a fancy chart and explanation about why the costs were so high. Never seeing any other gas tank supplier here I had not checked out other suppliers, but now I have. After contacting Calorgas I was amazed at their quoted price of £96 for 2 x 47kg tanks including VAT and delivery - £60 cheaper than Flogas! I went to my neighbour who also has Flogas to tell them the good news only to find that in 2 years they have never been asked to pay more than £100 for 2 x 47kg gas tanks from Flogas.

Clearly Flogas are charging some people, presumably older and more vulnerable people far more than others, because they can get away with it. This seems morally reprehensible and I think anyone using Flogas should be aware and check out the costs of bottled or tanked gas with other suppliers. I will never use Flogas again.

#### BRIDGERULE FOOTBALL CLUB

There was an air of uncertainty over Bridgerule F.C's future at the end of the 2015/2016 season. The Kingsley League had folded with little prior notification, our manager had retired after many years of service and consequently players were signing on for other clubs. At this point, few would have predicted a triumphant season for 2016/2017, yet indeed, that is what happened.

Having the attitude that he would rather play with the bare minimum of players than see the club fold, the club's longstanding Chairman Mike Tape took over the reins of management. With him, old players re-joined, new players signed on and thus Bridgerule began their first season in their new league, The North Devon League: Intermediate 2.

The club got off to a strong start and early on it was clear to see there was potential for this to be a successful season. As more and more games were won, the camaraderie and enthusiasm between the players grew (one player commuting from Bristol each week to play!); Mike was able to bring a full squad of high-calibre players to most games and faced difficult choices over who sat on the bench. In addition, numbers of spectators watching the games grew to levels not previously seen, with some also attending away games.

Efforts on the pitch were aided by support behind the scenes, such as the sponsorship of a new kit and training tops by local businesses, Howdens Joinery and Andrew Symons. A particular debt of gratitude is owed to Ray Wallace who has been collecting monies from local businesses in exchange for advertisement boards; however, many businesses have kindly donated money whilst declining to a have a board. He also generously gifted the club a ride-on lawnmower and we are thankful to Short and Abbott for the maintenance work they do and their continued support of the club.

It was in the league where Bridgerule, as new entrants, saw their triumph. As the season progressed, Bridgerule rose in the league table and for much of the season were sitting comfortably within the top 3. A spate of wins near the end of the season saw them attain the top-spot, but there was a nail-biting race to the finish line with rival contenders, Northam Lions having games in hand and the ability to beat Bridgerule on goal-difference. Thankfully, the nervous wait ended with Northam Lions unable to close the gap. Bridgerule, the club who started the season unsure of its future, were crowned the champions!

Next season Bridgerule will have two teams, so there will be plenty of opportunity for players to make their mark. Training begins on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July, 18:30 at Bridgerule F.C pitch and new players are welcome to attend.

The Club will be holding its annual Prize Bingo on the 27<sup>th</sup> July during Carnival Week; we hope you'll attend what is always a fun and entertaining event!






